A Motor Vehicle Records (MVRs) search is an excellent way to identify prospective employees with unsafe driving records and eliminate risk.

The alternative is to have the applicant go to the DMV to obtain their own record. This is not practical in most cases and is subject to fraud.

Information includes current status of the driving record and any violations that occurred within the state's reporting time frame.

A Motor Vehicle Records search will inform you on **administrative information** such as:

- Type of license
- Issue date
- Expiration date
- Restrictions

The search will also uncover **illegal information** like:

- Violations
- Disciplinary actions
- Convictions
- Revocations
- Suspensions
- Accidents
